## **POLICY 13.16**

### **THE ARMY CADET LEAGUE OF CANADA AWARDS ROCKY MOUNTAIN**

Executive Committee Authorization: October 22, 2006

#### **INTRODUCTION**

1. This Policy supercedes Cato 47-06 and 47-07 which have been rescinded by the Director Cadets and Junior Canadian Rangers.
2. The Army Cadet League of Canada has established an annual award for the top male and female cadets attending the Cadet Leadership and Challenge Course at the Rocky Mountain National Army Cadet Summer Training Centre (RMNACSTC), known as "The Army Cadet League of Canada Award (Rocky Mountain)". The National Office of the Army Cadet League of Canada administers the award.
3. A representative of the Army Cadet League of Canada will present the awards annually on the graduation parade at the RMNACSTC.
4. The awards will take the form of a gold watch with the RCAC emblem engraved on the dial.

#### **AUTHORITY**

5. Approving authority for the award nomination is the Army Cadet League of Canada.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

6. The following criteria shall be used as a basis for selecting the outstanding cadet:
  - a. dress and deportment;
  - b. willingness to accept duties and responsibilities;
  - c. demonstration of leadership qualities;
  - d. participation in off-duty programmes and activities;
  - e. exceptional physical fitness and endurance; and
  - f. course activity (to include level of achievement and effort displayed).



## **SELECTION BOARD**

7. A selection board shall be established at the Rocky Mountain NACSTC to ensure the most deserving cadet is selected for the award in accordance with the criteria.

## **NOTIFICATION**

8. The Regional Cadet Support Unit (Prairie) shall provide the name and cadet corps of the winning cadet to the ACLC National Office and DCdts 4-4, no later than 15 September each year.
