



POLICY 13.6

THE D. W. FLECK AWARD

Executive Committee Authorization: October 22, 2006

INTRODUCTION

1. This Policy supersedes CATO 47-08 which is repealed by the Director of Cadets and Junior Canadian Rangers (DCdts).
2. D. W. Fleck, a former President of the Army Cadet League of Canada, established an annual award for the most proficient army cadet pipe band musician attending the National Army Cadet Pipes and Drums course conducted at the Rocky Mountain National Army Cadet Summer Training Centre (RMNACSTC). The award is known as "The D. W. Fleck Award" and is administered by the National Office of the Army Cadet League of Canada.
3. The award takes the form of a presentation plaque.

AUTHORITY

4. Approving authority for the award nomination is the Army Cadet League of Canada.

SELECTION CRITERIA

5. The following criteria shall be used as a basis for selecting the recipient of the award:
 - a. dress and deportment;
 - b. drill;
 - c. cooperation;
 - d. punctuality;
 - e. effort;
 - f. attitude;
 - g. loyalty;
 - h. dedication;
 - i. honesty;
 - j. enthusiasm; and
 - k. musical progress/contribution.



SELECTION BOARD

6. A selection board shall be established at RMNACSTC to ensure the most deserving cadet is selected for the award in accordance with the criteria.

NOTIFICATION

7. Regional Cadet Support Unit (Prairie) shall provide the name and cadet corps of the winning cadet to the National Office of The Army Cadet League of Canada and to DCdts 4-4, NLT 15 Sep each year.
