



POLICY 13.7

THE LIEUTENANT-GENERAL C. H. BELZILE TROPHY FOR EXCELLENCE IN LARGEBORE MARKSMANSHIP

Executive Committee Authorization: October 21st, 2006

GENERAL

1. This Policy supersedes CATO 47-09 which is repealed by the Director Cadets and Junior Canadian Rangers.
2. Lieutenant-General C.H. Belzile, CM, CMM, CD, BA, LLD, a former Colonel Commandant Royal Canadian Army Cadets, as a legacy to his desire to promote the discipline of largebore rifle shooting in the Army Cadet movement, has established an annual award to be known as "The Lieutenant-General C.H. Belzile Trophy for Excellence in Largebore Shooting". The award is administered by the National Office of the Army Cadet League of Canada.
3. One award will be presented annually to the top shooter on the Army Cadet Bisley Team. The award will be presented in conjunction with the Graduation Parade of the Army Cadet National Training Centre (ACNTC) Connaught by Lieutenant-General C.H. Belzile personally or the Reviewing Officer at the Graduation Parade.

AUTHORITY

4. Approving authority for the award nomination is the National Office of the Army Cadet League of Canada.
5. The winning cadet is authorized by CATO 46-01 to wear the "Belzile Rifle Badge", on his/her uniform.





SELECTION CRITERIA

6. The criteria for selecting the top shooter will be determined by the Commandant of the Royal Canadian Army Cadet National Shooting Team in cooperation with the Commanding Officer of the ACNTC Connaught.

SELECTION BOARD

7. A selection board shall be established at the ACNTC Connaught comprising:
- a. Commandant Army Cadet Bisley Team;
 - b. Commanding Officer ACNTC Connaught; and
 - c. Executive Director, Army Cadet League of Canada.

NOTIFICATION

8. The Commanding Officer of the ACNTC Connaught shall provide the name and cadet corps of the winning cadet to the National Office of the Army Cadet League of Canada and to DCdts 4-4 NO LATER THAN 2 days prior to the graduation parade.
