LIFE MEMBERSHIP

1. Life Membership in the Army Cadet League of Canada is governed by Article 2.07 of By-Law 8 as follows:



2.07 Life Membership

Upon the recommendation of the National Council, the board (of Governors) may invite persons who have rendered distinguished service to the Army Cadet movement to be life members of the League. Life members shall be granted all privileges of membership without payment of dues. Life membership may be terminated by the incumbent or by resolution of the board or on the incumbent's death.

2. Any member in good standing of The Army Cadet League of Canada at the National or a Provincial /Territorial Branch may be nominated for National Life Membership.
3. Candidates for Life Membership will be considered from those members who have provided an outstanding contribution in any of the following areas:
 - Rendered outstanding service to the Army Cadet League of Canada; or
 - Served on a National or Branch Executive Committee; or
 - Been awarded the Executive or Governor of the Year Award; or is
 - A founding Member of a Provincial/ Territorial Branch; or
 - Provided outstanding leadership in the Provincial/Territorial Branches.
4. Any member can make nominations to the Branch President where the nominee is a member. This nomination should be in the form of a "citation". The National Office will solicit nominations annually in advance of the Annual General Meeting and a Nomination Form is included in the notification package sent to each Branch. If the Branch approves the nomination, the Branch President will complete the form and attach the citation. The nominees must be contacted to ensure that they are willing to accept the appointment. Provincial Vice-Presidents on the National Council should be prepared to justify the nomination and to answer questions from Council when the nomination is tabled.



5. Successful nominees will be advised by the National President.. A suitable certificate will be prepared by the National office and will include a brass metal membership card in the format pictured below, all to be and will be accompanied by a letter of congratulations by the National President.
